Times: Game times will be announced.
 ARRIVAL TIMES: Doors will be open 1 hour prior to tip off.

Locker Rooms: Dressing areas will be posted when you arrive.

Home Team: The home team will be the **TOP** team in the bracket and will wear their white uniforms. Please bring both sets of uniforms to each game just in case.

Opening Ceremonies: Teams will be allowed on the floor 25 minutes prior to game time. At the 5-minute mark, teams will report to their respective benches for introductions. For the first night only, all players will be introduced, beginning with the reserve players for the visiting team followed by the reserve players of the home team. Starting line-ups will be introduced alternating visiting and home team members. **PLEASE HAVE YOU PLAYERS MEET AT MID-COURT AND EXCHANGE HANDSHAKES.** All other games: Only starting line-ups will be introduced, again using the alternating method.

National Anthem: The Anthem will be performed prior to the start of the first session by the home team. We will not do the Anthem prior to the start of the second game. If a school has someone who would like to sing, please clear it with the gym supervisor and home team band director.

Game Balls: The home team will supply the game ball. It will be the state approved Baden ball. If the home team does not have an appropriate game ball, the visiting team will provide one. In the case of a conflict, the gym supervisor will provide one.

Rules: The 2011-12 National Federation High School Basketball Rules apply. Any further regulation can be found in the WIAA State

Tournament guidelines and/or District 4 guidelines.

Official Book: The official game book will be a paid worker scheduled by the gym supervisor.

Team Substitutions: Your official team line-up will be what is entered in the book the first night of the tournament. You cannot change your team members after your initial line-up is entered in the book. (This line-up is only for the district tournament, as you can change at the state level)

Make-up game: In case of inclement weather or unforeseen situations, the 2011-12 WIAA guidelines, and or the games committee members will determine the make-up policy. The games committee members will be: Tim Trimble, Howard Kreps, Neil Williamson, Jack Erwin and John Beckman.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded for 1st place only. Time will be allowed for the net cutting ceremony at the conclusion of the championship game and the presentation of the trophy. The teams playing the second game will be given 20 minutes of warm-up and we ask they stay off the floor until the ceremonies are completed.

Admission: Adults - \$6.00
Seniors/students w/ASB - \$4.00
There will be no all-tournament pass offered.

Passes: Each participating school will be given 21 participant passes:
15 for players/coaches
2 managers
1 school photographer
2 stat keepers
1 score keeper

School Administrators can use their District IV passes.
Superintendents and School Board members can use their District IV passes.
