

- Rules:** The National Federation High School Basketball Rules apply. Any further regulation can be found in the WIAA State Tournament guidelines and/or District IV guidelines.
- Official Book:** The official game book will be a paid worker scheduled by the gym supervisor.
- Team Substitutions:** Your official team line-up will be what is entered in the book the first night of the tournament. You cannot change your team members after your initial line-up is entered in the book. (This line-up is only for the district tournament, as you can change for the state level)
- Make-up game:** In case of inclement weather or unforeseen situations, the WIAA guidelines, and or the games committee members will determine the make-up policy. The games committee members will be: Dan Clark, Josh Lowe and Robert Blackman.
- Awards:** Trophies will be awarded on Friday evening, 2/17 for 1st and 2nd place. Time will be allotted for the net cutting ceremony at the conclusion of the first game and the presentation of the trophy. The teams playing the second game will be given 20 minutes of warm-up and we ask they stay off the floor until the ceremonies are completed.
- On Tuesday, 2/21, trophies for 3rd and 4th will be presented at the conclusion of the consolation games.

- Passes:** Each participating school will be given 21 participant passes:
- 15 for players
 - 2 managers
 - 1 school photographer
 - 2 stat keepers
 - 1 score keeper
- Each school will receive 8 supervisory passes:
- 3 coaches
 - 3 bus drivers
- School Administrators can use their District IV passes. Superintendents and School Board members can use their District IV Passes. **THERE WILL BE NO PASS GATE LISTS!**

Program: Program prices will be \$5.00. Each team will receive 5 complimentary programs the first evening of the tournament. The site manager will be responsible for selling programs and keeping the money separate from the gate receipts.

 3. Please let the site managers know if you are bringing a band.
 4. School supervisors must check in with the site manager upon arrival. One school supervisor must be present at each game.

I will be able to pull the information from their website to put together our District program. **THIS INFORMATION NEEDS TO BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JANUARY 20th.** I will need the game scores **separately**. I will also need for you to send me the advertising information (DUE JANUARY 20th) and the names, in order, that go under the photos. If you do not have advertising I will put something else in that area for you. After entering information please make sure you click on the "[Profile ready for program](#)". If your team makes it to the State tournament you will need to remember to update your games & points average by February 20th. **ALL TEAMS WILL BE IN THE DISTRICT TOURNAMENT WHETHER THEY QUALIFY OR NOT.**

Your roster and picture are for program purposes only. Your official tournament roster will be determined by the names in the scorebook at the beginning of your first tournament game. The cost of the programs will be \$5 each this year.
